## Bath adds a black splash

Bath & North East Somerset Council has granted planning for Mitchell Taylor Workshop's complementary health clinic and martial arts centre in Bath city centre.

The 680sq m project features cantilevered boxes over the river, with large windows to admit light without compromising patients' privacy. The building will be clad in black dry slate, black ribbed timber and copper.

Practice director Piers Taylor said: "In one sense it's completely alien in choice of materials and form, but we convinced [the council] that it's utterly site-specific, so it had to look different."
