Low-tech designs from this year's Studio in the Woods summer school have been revealed.

The school, now in its fifth year, was held on the Isle of Wight last weekend, led by award-winning architects from Studio Weave, Feilden Clegg Bradley and Mole Architects.

According to Piers Taylor of Mitchell Taylor Workshop, those taking part "felled and milled trees into teepees, treehouses, solar collectors, platforms and rolling sculptures" at New Barn Farm.

The workshops focus on "explorations into making" and "the direct experience of making and working with materials to hand".
